All adults attending Glow are considered sponsors and must submit a signed sponsor form, including mothers. If a mother is unable to attend, her daughter may come with a sponsor. Sponsors must be 21 or older and a ratio of 1 sponsor to 7 girls is required.

Sponsor forms are provided with the registration form. Churches must approve those attending as sponsors and sponsor forms must be signed by someone from the church other than the sponsor or a family member of the sponsor.

Refund and Cancellation Policies

Registration cost will not be refunded after March 20 (late registration deadline) except for an official travel advisory by the Highway Patrol.
